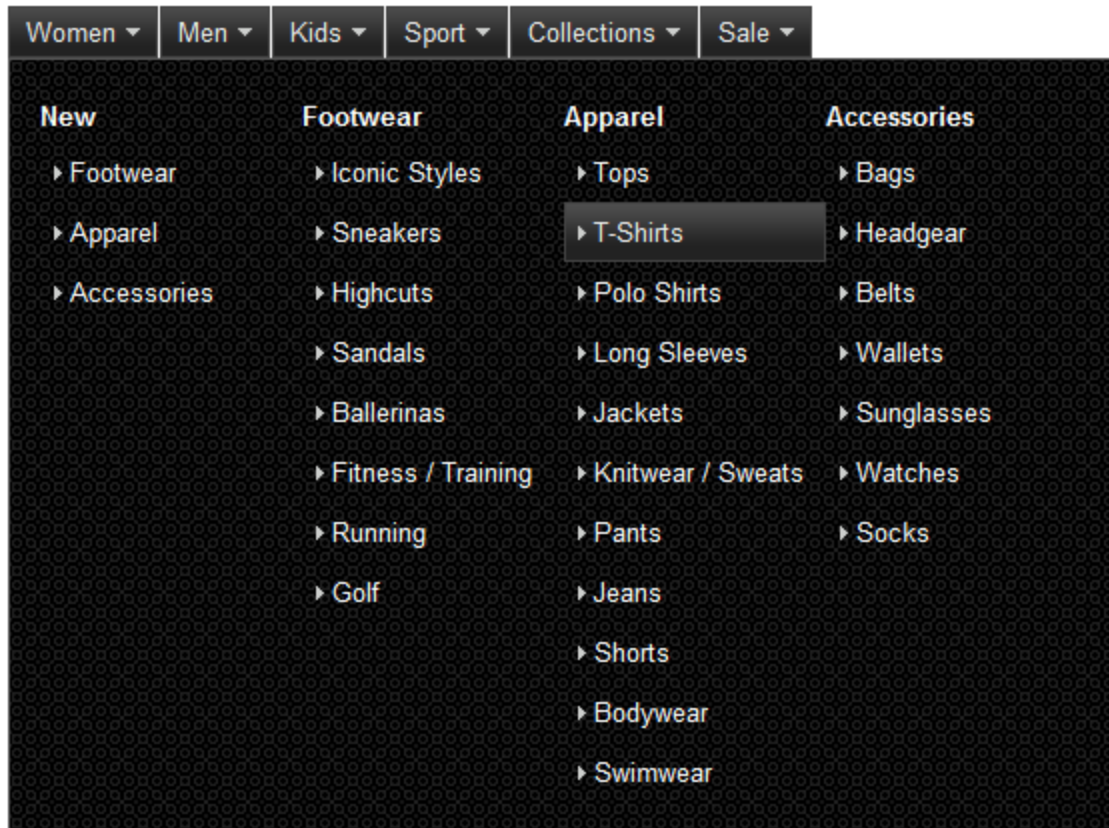


MegaMenu - Version 1.0

Mega Menus are drop down menus that contain multiple columns of links. They enable access to all links at once, rather than forcing the user to scroll or use sub-menus. Now you can join the new trend in navigation by adding the MegaMenu extension to your website!

The MegaMenu was created using jQuery and supports the same ThemeRoller themes as the other jQuery based components.



General Properties

You will use the General page of the properties to add, edit and remove menu items to the MegaMenu.

Click 'Add' to insert a new button to the main menu bar. The properties of the button give you access to the submenu.

Button Text

Specifies the text of the button.

Menu Layout

Specifies how the items in the submenu will be displayed.

- Columns only
All categories will be displayed in columns (1 row).
- Rows only
All categories will be displayed in rows (1 column).
- 2 columns
Categories will be displayed in 2 columns.
- 3 columns
Categories will be displayed in 3 columns.
- 4 columns
Categories will be displayed in 2 columns

Links are organized in categories. To add a new category click the 'Add category' button and specify a name.

To add a link to a category, first select the category name and then click 'Add Link'.

You can rearrange the links with the 'Move Up' and 'Move Down' button or by using drag & drop.

Style Properties

ThemeRoller Theme

Select one of the available themes to quickly change the appearance of the MegaMenu. By default the WYSIWYG Web Builder comes with a few ready-to-use themes. However you can easily create custom themes by visiting the ThemeRoller website: <http://jqueryui.com/themeroller/>

New themes must be installed in the 'themeroller' folder of WYSIWYG Web Builder:
My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\themeroller\

The '**Font name**' and '**Font Size**' properties can be used to override the default font of the theme.

The '**Animation**' property enables the fade animation for hiding and showing sub menus.

Button Padding

Specifies the padding for the buttons. The Button text in combination with the padding determines the size of the button.

Button Spacing

Specifies the spacing between the button.

Icon

Specifies the icon displayed on the button.

Icon Offset

Specifies the position of the icon on the button.

If the value is positive, the icon will be aligned on the left side of the button.

If the value is negative, the icon will be aligned on the right side of the button.

Sub Menu Padding

Specifies the padding for the sub menu.

Icon

Specifies the icon displayed on the left side of the links.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\

WYSIWYG Web Builder 7.1 or higher

Known limitations

You can only use one MegaMenu per page.
